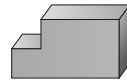
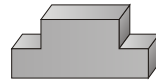
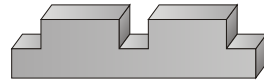
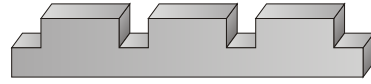


Sample dimensions.

Obviously you can change dimensions to suit your purpose or the size of the scrap lumber you'd like to utilize.



- For thinner lumber you'd want thinner dados.
- Wider spacing between dados will enlarge your pattern for a given lumber size.
- As long as the 2 dimensions are consistent, an endless variety of patterns can be assembled.
- Make a pile of long, identical pieces and cut them shorter as you need them.

Test one small section of your chosen pattern to make sure the pieces will all fit together. Some pieces will be "up" and some will be "down, as you lock them together. You might end up with one "up" and one "down" end for the last piece and need to adjust your pattern to suit.
